## PATHWAY TO LICENSURE

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### DECLARE YOUR EDUCATION MAJOR OR MINOR

- An advisor will be assigned to help navigate your program
- Complete FBI background check before your 1st field experience

### COMPLETE 100 & 200 LEVEL CLASSES

- Earn a C- or higher in all required classes
- Earn positive dispositional assessments

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### APPLY TO THE PROGRAM

- Your advisor will let you know when it's time to Apply to the Program. Eligibility requirements:
  - completed all 100 & 200 level classes with a C- or higher
  - have a cumulative GPA of 2.5

### AFTER ADMISSION TO PROGRAM

- Review Handbook
- Complete all remaining classes with a C- or higher
- Attend Professional Developments
- Maintain good grades and dispositions
- Login to Student Learning & Licensure (SL&L) account
- Complete required modules

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### APPLY TO STUDENT TEACH, SPRING SEMESTER

- Attend the junior meeting
- Complete placement questionnaire
- Set up an appointment to meet with the Director of Field Experience

### PERMISSION TO STUDENT TEACH

- To be eligible to student teach you must:
  - have a cumulative GPA of 2.5 or higher
  - have an education GPA of 2.75 or higher
  - have a major GPA of 2.50 or higher
  - pass all required classes with a C- or higher

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### STUDENT TEACHING AND LICENSURE

- Obtain a BCI and FBI background check
- Prepare and submit the edTPA
- Complete all modules for your program
- Meet CFAST expectations
- Pass all licensure exams
- Complete student teaching hours
- Graduate
- Apply for license with Ohio Dept of Education

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
