EARNING TWO MAJORS OR A MAJOR / MINOR COMBINATION FROM OUR DEPARTMENT

- 1) Certain combinations of majors and minors are not allowed. These are outlined on the chart on the other side of this sheet.
- 2) If you are attempting to obtain two majors from our department, any courses that are required of *both* majors can be double counted. In addition, *two* additional courses can be double counted. For example, if you wish to earn both B.A. MATH and B.A. COMP:

Because M202 and C150 are required of both majors, you only need to take those courses once.

However, since COMP 250 is required of the B.A. COMP but an *elective* for the B.A. MATH, it will be one of your *two* double counted courses.

- 3) For a major/ minor combination, all courses that are required of *both* programs double counted. *One* additional course can be double counted.
- 4) Student planning and online degree audits will *not* catch these rules. Be sure to stay in contact with your advisor.
- 5) It is possible to earn *two* degrees from our department. To obtain two degrees, you must earn 158 credits from Witt. But you should talk to an advisor immediately about this because earning two degrees may not be exactly what you expect.

For example, it will take 158 credits to graduate with a B.S. degree with a major in Mathematics and a B.A. degree in Computer Science.

It will take 126 credits to graduate with a B.S. degree with majors in Mathematics and Computer Science. This can happen EVEN THOUGH WE DON'T HAVE A B.S. DEGREE in COMPUTER SCIENCE. Here is the important Academic Catalog language:

“A student completing more than one major will receive one degree with all majors listed in the official transcript. In the case of a student who completes more than one major in two separate degree programs (e.g. the Bachelor of Arts and Bachelor of Science), all majors will be listed in the transcript, but the student will choose the degree to be awarded. (The choice of the degree cannot be changed after Commencement.)

If a student has completed the requirements of graduating with two degrees from Wittenberg University, the student will receive two degrees with all majors listed in the official transcript.”
