Understanding Residency Requirements

As a residential campus, Wittenberg expects all full-time students to live in university owned housing.

Common Exceptions:

- 1. Commute from the principal residence of their parent/legal guardian that is within a 30 miles driving distance
- 2. Live in a Greek organization house
- 3. Fill an RA position for the coming academic year
- 4. Study abroad for the term

Do not make plans until you receive the Residence Life decision

Students who apply for exemption with inaccurate information (e.g. a student who indicates they will be commuting from parent/legal guardian primary residence but is instead renting from a private landlord in town) will be charged through the student conduct system and can be held responsible the standard double room rate.



The Basic Process

Incoming Student Housing Intention

Complete the Incoming Student Intention form to let us know if you plan to live in campus housing or are seeking housing release

- Log into your Incoming Student Portal
- Log into the Housing System with your Wittenberg email and password
- Click on "Forms and Applications"
- Click the "Incoming Student Housing Intention" link







Not planning to live in campus housing

- Review the Residency Requirement
- Complete the Housing Release Form

Planning to live in campus housing

 Proceed to Housing Agreement and Survey



Complete Housing Agreement and Housing Survey (same form)

- Log into your Incoming Student Portal
- Log into the Housing System with your Wittenberg email and password
- Click on "Forms and Applications"
- Click the "Incoming Student Housing Agreement and Survey" link
- Sign the Housing Agreement
- Complete the Housing Survey
- Preference your placements

Incoming Student Housing Intention and Agreement

Step 1

Log into the Housing Portal with your Wittenberg email and password (via MyWitt or housing.wittenberg.edu)

Step 2

Click on "Forms & Applications"

Step 3

Complete the Housing Intention

Click on "Incoming Student Housing Intention"
Complete the housing intention
Once completed, the Housing Agreement will
be available under "Forms & Applications"

Step 4

Review and Sign your Housing Agreement

Once the Housing Intent is completed, the "Housing Agreement" will be available under "Forms & Applications"

A pdf copy will be emailed to you afterwards.

Step 5

Review the option for Renter's Insurance & make your selection

GradGuard is not required, just an option.

All students should sure they have coverage for personal property.

Once you complete the GradGuard section, click "Return to Application" to be directed back to the Housing Site.





Step 6

Complete your vaccination disclosure and housing survey questions

If you don't remember the specifics about your vaccinations, provide as much accurate information as you can or ask a parent/guardian.

Vaccinations are not required, so please put a "0" on the "year received line" for any vaccines not received; otherwise you won't be able to complete the form.

Step 7

Preference your Housing



As noted in your housing agreement, Wittenberg University does not assume any financial responsibility for the personal property of students. We strongly recommend that all students obtain renters insurance prior to move in. Here are some scenarios in which renters insurance can help:

- Nou leave your laptop in the library unattended as you grab lunch, to later find that it was stolen.
- You return to the residence halls after class, to find that someone accidentally caused a fire on your floor and the smoke ruined all of your clothes, books and bedding.
- 😵 You accidentally hang your clothes on the sprinkler head. Water damage destroys your stuff and the belongings of other residents on your floor.

We have partnered with GradGuard, which offers a College Renters Insurance Plan that is specifically designed for students. For about \$13 per month, GradGuard can protect you in the scenarios listed above and more.


Students are not required to get these vaccinations – only disclose whether or not they have received them.


Honors (Woodlawn)




Rank Your Hall Selections


Step 1: Familiarize yourself with the location of hall



Step 2: Use the pull down under Request Type, and select Residence Hall Selection –Incoming Students




Step 3: Select your first hall choice and click "Add".
