- o There is a motion this week that was passed reducing the number of student senate representatives from 8 (currently) to 6 (new number for next semester) to reduce the percentage of student representatives by 25% in accordance with the 25% faculty cut next year. Dr. Rosenberg, Chair of the Faculty Executive Board, explained that "One of the motions [being made on Tuesday] is to reduce the number of students from 8 to 6. This pretty much keeps the proportions the same as the faculty is being reduced by 25% as well. The number of students being set at 8 actually was established when there were 130 faculty members. This is not meant to disrespect students or mute their voice, but rather just to make the numbers align. If you have concerns or want to discuss it, let me know, I just didn't want to blindside you and other students on Tuesday."
- o Six members of the Student Senate met with the FEB at 3:30 today to discuss this and we all understood the rationale and are ready to proceed with adjusting our bylaws in the coming weeks to align with the new motion.
 - Our current senator representatives are: President, Faculty Student Senator, Student Athletics Representative, Cultural Diversity Senator, and four class representatives (First-year, sophomore, junior, senior).

- ii. This was approved with the faculty meeting vote this afternoon. I am suggesting that as of next year, we move to a numerical-based representation over a position-based representation.
 - 1. Thoughts or comments? My plan is to make a motion to change the constitution next week because the faculty just voted today.
- o The Faculty Meeting on December 3rd was informative. Read more about what was discussed in the folder on Student Senate's Teams.
- After I was selected to serve as the student representative on the Presidential Search Committee, I was put in contact with Doug Kentfield, the chair of the Presidential Search Committee and a long time Board member.
 - i. Thank you to all who voiced their opinions at the student listening sessions and through the email survey. I will try my hardest to advocate for the needs of the student body in the next president.
 - ii. Updates: We have our work cut out for us as we try to find a candidate who will best serve Wittenberg's dynamic needs and multiple vacancies. Along with me, the 14 members of the search committee including 3 faculty, 1 staff, 1 Alumni Board representative, 1 Emeritus Board member, and 8 members of the Board of Directors:

- iii. This month, our goals include gathering applicant candidates and reviewing their credentials.
- iv. We also created a president search profile of Wittenberg to distribute to candidates.
- v. We will meet at least another 6 times throughout the semester as the search continues, and I will continue to update my meeting minutes accordingly with our progress.

o Committee Updates:

- There are some changes coming to committee structures next semester to streamline the University governance structure with the changes coming to the faculty next year.
- ii. Educational Policies Committee
 - At the Faculty Meeting, there was a motion to approve the revision to PSYC 251: Psychopathology and make it an asynchronous course next semester.
 - 2. The other courses that were approved for revisions were as follows:
 - a. CMDM 201 removed a prerequisite of CMDM 101.
 - The biology department asked to mark multiple courses as inactive because there are no professors to teach anymore:
 - i. BIOL 104: Evolution of Animal Sex
 - ii. BIOL 130: The Botanical world (because the course was listed twice)
 - iii. BIOL 133: Intro to Ornithology
 - iv. BIOL 140: Understanding Evolution

- v. BIOL 219: Immunology
- vi. BIOL 226: Vertebrate Zoology
- vii. BIOL 238: Entomology
- viii. BIOL 241: Freshwater Ecology
- ix. BIOL 242: Behavioral Ecology
- x. BIOL 316: Molecular Genetics and Bioinformatics
- xi. BIOL 347: Evolution
- c. The Biology Department asked to change the name of "BIOL 201: Biological Literacy" to "BIOL 201: Technical Writing". They also requested to change the title of "BIOL 227: Microbiology" to "BIOL 227: Microbiology and immunology"
- d. The Biology Department also asked to change the course descriptions of "BIOL 204: Medical Terminology I" and "BIOL 204: Medical Terminology II" to include the phrase "Course registration is open to pre-health professional students only."
- iii. The Program Review and Assessment Committee
 - Patton and Simpson serve. We will meet next in March and will discuss the size of the committee then.
- iv. The Athletic Policy and Recreation Committee.
 - Harper and McCans serve. This committee is being sunsetted by next semester.
- v. Diversity Advisory Committee
 - Peña and Livingston serve. This committee is merging with the programming board by next semester and will have increased responsibilities in the future.
- vi. Facilities and Environment Committee.

- 1. Raymond and Patton serve. There have been no meetings. This committee is being sunsetted by next semester.
- vii. General Education Advisory Committee meets on Wednesdays, 1:50-2:50 (in science 243.).
 - As of this semester, they are moving to Wednesday from 4:10 to
 5:10. One more student is needed to serve on this committee.
 - 2. Livingston serves, but one more student would be appreciated because he is no longer available.
 - a. Pena will be serving this semester due to the date change.
 - 3. The committee celebrated Dr. Mattison's work on the committee before he left in December.
 - 4. They also discussed Dr. Collier's proposed changes to the biology department, described in the EPC report above.
- viii. International and Field Studies committee:
 - Miloser, Slenk, and Patton serve. There have been no meetings.
 This committee is continuing next semester.
- o For your information, Faculty committees are changing. The Programming Board, Athletic Policy and Recreation Committee, Facilities and Environment Committee, and the Board of Directors Liaisons are being sunsetted. This is designed to "accommodate the decreased number of faculty positions at Wittenberg beginning in Fall 2025."
